Kaiapoi River walkway

Flowing through the centre of Kaiapoi is a recently developed walkway that follows the top of the riverbank. The last section is currently being constructed and when all completed, the walkway alongside the Kaiapoi River will be approximately 5kms. The sealed track is also suitable for scooters, bikes, buggies and wheelchairs. Weaving into the walk, along the riverbank are four art obelisks and sculptural features that are lit in the evening, creating a dramatic effect to the walkway experience.

A March opening of the Dudley Aquatic Centre will see this new bright and modern facility being well used by locals and visitors. An eight lane 25 metre pool, a 20 metre teaching pool, a recreational pool that includes a bubble pit and whirlpool, and also a spa pool give lots of options for training and recreation. Open all year round the covered pool will be a fantastic recreational facility for all ages.
