1st Cust Craft Group

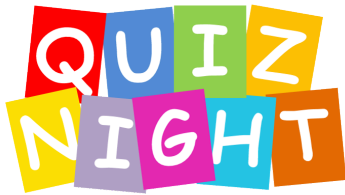
10am, Cust Community Centre. Knitters, crocheters, embroiderers and quilters are all welcome.
